General Conditions

1. All shooting activities on the shooting range must be covered by a current public liability insurance policy.
2. The shooting range must be maintained in a condition so as to comply with the requirements listed in the "Firearms Ranges - Standards For Approval" manual.
3. The shooting range will comply with all conditions imposed by the responsible Local Government Authority (if applicable)
4. No alterations or extensions shall be made to the shooting range without the prior approval of the Chief Commissioner.
5. This shooting range approval may be revoked or the conditions of the approval varied by the Chief Commissioner.
6. Range Safety Orders must be visibly displayed in a prominent place for all persons at the shooting range to see.
7. This Range Approval Certificate or a copy thereof must be visibly displayed in a prominent place for all persons at the shooting range to see.

Special Conditions (if applicable)

1. The Combined Upper Yarra Rifle Clubs Range Association range is approved for:
 - full bore rifle shooting from the prone position in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Victorian Rifle Association.
 - field class rifle shooting in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Victorian Rifle Association.
 - law enforcement firearms training using handguns, shotguns, centrefire rifle and rimfire rifle, and
 - Australia Deer Association training courses.

2. All law enforcement firearm training, except centrefire rifle, must be conducted within 25 metres of the mantlet and using the mantlet as the stop butt.
3. All Australian Deer Association training course must be conducted in accordance with Appendix 1 - ADA Process and Procedure dated 16/4/2010
4. Any previous approval for this range is replaced by the approval number 118B-2001 dated 16/4/2010.

NOTE: Failure to comply with any condition of the shooting range approval may result in the revocation of the approval
